

SCC Meeting Minutes
March 9, 2016
(revised)

Jeff Andrews opened in prayer.

Minutes from the January 13 congregational meeting and February 10 SCC meeting were approved.

Harry Davis, Ralph Rowley, and Terry Jenkins provided an update from a city zoning meeting. They report that there was a positive meeting. The city staff indicated there were no barriers to approving renovations to the current Potter's House site within the existing external walls. They also noted that while it might be possible to expand the footprint, doing so would require a conditional use permit. Finally they suggested that we should anticipate opposition from surrounding neighborhoods if Potters House were relocated to another location.

Heidi Beauchaine reported that the current plan has appropriate use for Seaside School classroom. However, there is no space on the third floor to provide child care options to ministry groups that meet during the day. This could be a problem if second grade floors are all changed to adult classrooms. Benson met with a team of ministry and child care providers to look at ways the ministries could work together to meet the needs of all. They feel that if programs are going to continue to expand, changes will need to be made to the current building plan. Decisions like this are for the CLC to make, not our committee.

Heather McEntee reviewed the draft PowerPoint presentation to be shared during small group meetings. Terry requested that SCC members sign up to facilitate these meetings. Terry provided information regarding additional square footage provided by the new building. The net total will be shared in the PowerPoint. The committee recommended that information regarding seating capabilities and flexibility of the multipurpose space be added to the PowerPoint. It was suggested that key questions and concerns be shared with Terry for consideration in upcoming presentations. If audience members ask questions that presenters cannot answer, presenters will take down the questions so answers can be obtained.
