- Checks calendar for scheduled time to work and be sure to arrive on time for each shift.
- Takes a training course in CPR and First Aid for children and infants.
- Follows all policies in the "Childcare Policies" packet
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Children's Ministry Director or Childcare Staff Attendant 3.

- Be of good character and be of Christian faith. (Dependable, honest and responsible)
- Physically, mentally, and emotionally healthy.
- Have experience with caring for children and their needs.
- Adaptive to a variety of situations and participate in periodic training events.
- Have a Christian loving attitude toward others, especially children and parents.
- Willing to socialize and interact with the children by sharing bible stories, lessons and songs.
