

Second Century Committee Meeting  
August 13, 2014

Chuck Cassidy opened the meeting in prayer. Minutes from the July meeting were reviewed and approved.

Updates:

- Terry reported meeting of committee members (Karen, Terry, Benson, Jeff) with Potters House Leadership Team to discuss. Volunteers from Potters House continue to be committed to their work and expressed flexibility in considering facility options.
- Terry reported meeting with Seton House to share information. They are willing to come and meet with congregation to share their work with teens. Used to work in Fellowship Hall. Terry also met with Stand Up For Kids who also are willing to share info regarding their work.
- There has been some discussion among the Trustees regarding the age of the population being served by outside groups. (For example, serving those above teen age limits.) This will be explored later and given consideration in ensuring safety guidelines are followed.

New Business:

Jeff Andrews provided an update from CLC regarding Town Hall Meetings. The purpose is to get a sense of where congregation stands in case of mission priorities and issues related to 18th St. property. Emails have gone out to the entire congregation and announcements have been made in Sunday School. Dates are August 19 and September 2. Meetings will be in the Fellowship Hall.

The committee discussed the need to emphasize that it is a process. The first meeting is to gather information. Participants will be given an opportunity to write down answers to guided questions to be answered later. People will also be able to provide answers to guided questions in writing (in person or via email) prior to the September 2 meeting. A FAQ page will be developed to address the top questions.

Committee Reviewed Power Point Presentation and suggested slight changes. Additional changes can be sent to Terry through Friday. The format for the meeting was also finalized.
