

## Something in the Water Discussion Questions

### Acts 8:26-39

1. What comes to mind when you hear the word evangelist? What associations, positive or negative, do you have with that word?
2. Pastor Matt shares Ezra Pound's definition of a good story as "news that stays news." Where do you go to hear stories that feed your soul?
3. *Read Acts 8:27.* What are your first impressions of the Ethiopian court official?
4. What does it mean to you to be an outsider? When have you felt like an outsider?
5. Even as an outsider, the Ethiopian official is influential. What are some areas of your life that you have an impact on others?
6. Share a time when you felt like you were in the right place at the right time. How had God prepared you for that moment? What was the impact of your experience?
7. *Read Acts 8:32-35.* Imagine what Philip shared to connect the passage of Isaiah to the good news of Jesus. As a group, put that message into your own words.
8. Pastor Matt issued a challenge to be an evangelist. Can you think of a person that you can share the good news with? How can your group help you to take the next step as an evangelist?
